

# Yarn Command vs NPM Command

Use the following command :

```
yarn add [package_name]
```

## Comparing npm and Yarn Commands

### Install dependencies

```
npm install => yarn
```

### Install a package

```
npm install [package_name] => yarn add [package_name]
```

### Install a package globally

```
npm install -g [package_name] => yarn global add [package_name]
```

### Install a package as a development dependency

```
npm install --save-dev [package_name] => yarn add --dev [package_name]
```

### Uninstall a package

```
npm uninstall [package_name] => yarn remove [package_name]
```

### Uninstall a package globally

```
npm uninstall -g [package_name] => yarn global remove [package_name]
```

## Uninstall a development dependency package

```
npm uninstall --save-dev [package_name] => yarn remove [package_name]
```

## Update the dependencies

```
npm update => yarn upgrade
```

## Update a package

```
npm update [package_name] => yarn upgrade [package_name]
```

## Create a new package

```
npm init => yarn init
```

## Run a script defined in the package.json

```
npm run => yarn run
```

## Test a package

```
npm test => yarn test
```

## Publish a package

```
npm publish => yarn publish
```

## Remove all data from the cache

```
npm cache clean => yarn cache clean
```
